


FROM PASTOR JAY

Busy, But Not Too Busy





Rise Against Hunger is one of the best events of the year in my opinion. Everyone is always so excited, and we accomplish so much in a short period of time. I just love how this church comes together for this event!

The very next week is the Outreach Yard Sale. It always amazes me how they find all the things that they sell and even more how much God blesses them with what they sell it for. It is not too late to donate and certainly not too late to mark your calendars to be there for the preview night and the rest of the week. Whether you are donating, volunteering or buying, we need you to make this event great!

Next up is Youth Sunday. After much debate we have decided to make this a combined service in the CLC. Even if this isn't your favorite style of worship, I really want to challenge you to come out and support the kids. They have been practicing 2 – 3 times a week to get ready for this service. This is also our first true youth service in many years. I am also excited that our own Jordan will be sharing the message. I really want to encourage you to be a part of this service.

As I expressed in my opening, we end the month with Easter. As has been the case in recent years we will offer three services on Easter Sunday morning. We will offer a sunrise service at 6:45 AM in the picnic shelter. This service will be informal—some people might even still have their pajamas on and we will not have communion. At 9AM we will meet in the CLC for our normal contemporary service and IIAM we will worship in the Sanctuary for our traditional service. We will have communion at both times. Each of these three services is a uniquely different way to celebrate the Resurrection. The flower cross will be available at all services.

That sure sounds like a lot of extra things going on at JPC. When you combine these with the other Lenten events I haven't even mentioned along with the normal weekly meetings and events, it seems like we could get caught up in the busyness of the month and forget the true meaning. Even if we are able to attend some or all of these things, it is easy to forget that for these 40 days we remember that Jesus was willing to complete God's plan for our justification and he allowed Himself to go to the cross for us.

Don't let the Lenten season pass you by. Take a few moments and spend some extra time with the Lord. You can read the story of Holy Week in the Bible and we can always find more time to pray. I want you to be a part of all of these events but more than that, I want to challenge you to draw closer to your heavenly Father these last days of Lent. I know in my personal life that when I am the busiest I allow for my time with God to be the area I cut time. It doesn't make sense does it? In the season when we remember and focus on God's willingness to sacrifice His Son on the cross we should not spend less time in His presence. Each of the things I listed can be a way to draw you closer to the Lord, even in fellowship and fun. At Rise Against Hunger we ring the gong after every 1000 meals but what if you took a moment and thanked God for some blessing each time it rang?

Before I go, I want to mention a few other events. Don't forget the Cantata on Maundy Thursday, the Easter Egg Hunt, the next Life Center Study, and all the other great opportunities at JPC this month. I close my article the same way each month and this way more than ever I mean it when I say, "See you in church!"


YOUTH NEWS!
